

## **Motion and Result for IACP 2011**

### **MOTION 1: The following motion was passed**

The Northern Ireland Committee propose that a new reduced rate be introduced for annual subscription for Counsellors / Psychotherapists who are Senior Citizens, in line with other professional bodies.

### **Rationale**

It has been brought to our attention that many Members over the age of 60 do not work full time. Consequently, the motion requests IACP Members to look favourably on Counsellors / Psychotherapists in this age group by reducing the amount due on re-accreditation fees. We have also been made aware that BACP, for example, have a reduced fee for Senior Citizens.
